## From Our Pastor:

In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 10:26-33), Jesus Christ tells the Twelve Apostles to "fear no one." He instructs them to "speak in the light" and to acknowledge Him as the Only Savior of the world and proclaim Him from the housetops! To do so, we cannot be afraid to open our life completely in word and deed to Jesus Christ, to be instruments of His love and mercy. Thus, when Pope Saint John Paul II began his ministry in Saint Peter's Square in October 1978, his main words were "Do not be afraid! Open wide the doors for Christ!" Today, as much as ever, the world needs our witness to this life-affirming, peaceful message of the Gospel.

Pope Benedict XVI said that Saint John Paul II was also addressing the mighty, the powerful of this world, who feared that Christ might take away something of their power if they were to let Him in, if they were to allow the faith to be free. And Jesus would, Pope Benedict said (April 24, 2005), for He would certainly take away their corruption, their attempts to control people's lives, their dictatorship of relativism, but Jesus "would not have taken away anything that pertains to human freedom or dignity, or to the building of a just society."

"The Pope was also speaking to everyone, especially the young," Pope Benedict said. "Are we not perhaps all afraid in some way?," he asked. "If we let Christ enter fully into our lives, if we open ourselves totally to Him, are we not afraid that He might take something away from us? Are we not perhaps afraid to give up something significant, something unique, something that makes life so beautiful? Do we not then risk ending up diminished and deprived of our freedom? And once again the Pope said: No! If we let Christ into our lives, we lose nothing, nothing, absolutely nothing of what makes life free, beautiful and great. No! Only in this friendship are the doors of life opened wide. Only in this friendship is the great potential of human existence truly revealed. Only in this friendship do we experience beauty and liberation. And so, today, with great strength and great conviction, on the basis of long personal experience of life, I say to you, dear young people: Do not be afraid of Christ! He takes nothing away, and He gives you everything. When we give ourselves to Him, we receive a hundredfold in return. Yes, open, open wide the doors to Christ – and you will find True Life. Amen."

As Bishop Donald J. Hying sends me on July 1st to be a parochial vicar at four Catholic churches and two Catholic schools in Sun Prairie, Marshall and Waterloo, please know that I thank God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for the privilege to serve you, the parish family of Saint Clement, our church and school, these past nearly six years (to sanctify, teach, govern), and that I pray for you all every day, especially at Mass, that God gives you, us and all our families His saving grace, peace and strength, and an increase in His virtues of faith, hope and love, in our journey to our purpose in life, Heaven. I thank God for the privilege to have served God and His Church with a faithful, dedicated and wonderful staff and faculty, and Knights of Columbus, Council of Catholic Women, and various groups and volunteers here at Saint Clement. Thanks be to God for our life, for faith, hope, love, families and friends, for His Church, Word, Sacraments, His gift of prayer, Communion of Saints and all His teachings. Let us keep praying for one another. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus and our mother, and Saint Joseph, Saint Clement and all the saints and angels keep us close to Jesus Christ and always intercede for us. And may God, who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, bless you now and always. Amen.

### **PARISH DIRECTORY UPDATE**

If you were not able to have your photo taken during our parish directory photography dates, we are now accepting submitted photos. The preference of the directory company is to have these submitted digitally. This means that you will need to email us the photo you want to have included in the directory. If possible, it should be a vertical photo rather than a wide-shot horizontal picture. A few things to keep in mind:

- If the photo was professionally taken (except by a church directory company), you will need to get a copyright release.
- If you are taking a photo of a photo, set the camera resolution to the highest setting. Scanning the photo at high resolution works even better.
- Send the photo as an attachment via email to the parish address: st clement@tds.net.
- In the email, be sure to tell us the names of everyone in the photo, children oldest to youngest.
- The photo should be in either .pdf or .jpg form.
- The cost for photo submission is \$15.00. This is what the parish has to pay the company for submitted photos. You will receive a directory by doing so.
- If you do not have email, stop at the office, and we can scan the photo for you.
- Please submit your photo to the parish office by July 31! If you have any questions, contact Bill Manthe at the parish office.
