THIRD WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The "World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly" was established three years ago, and it is celebrated in most countries on the Sunday before the

Feast of Sts. Joachim & Anne (July 26), the parents of our Blessed Mother, and Grandparents of Our Lord Jesus Christ. In it, we recognize the importance of family, its shared history of hopes and dreams, and the community of love and care that is its bond. Below is a portion of Pope Francis' Message.

"Dear brothers and sisters! 'His mercy is from age to age' (Lk 1:50). This is the theme of the *Third World Day for Grandparents* and the Elderly, and it takes us back to the joyful meeting between the young Mary and her elderly relative Elizabeth (cf. Lk 1:39-56). Filled with the Holy Spirit, Elizabeth addressed the Mother of God with words that continue to echo in our daily prayer: 'Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb' (v. 42). The Holy Spirit, who had earlier descended upon Mary, prompted her to respond with the Magnificat, in which she proclaimed that the Lord's mercy is from generation to generation. That same Spirit blesses and accompanies every fruitful encounter between different generations: between grandparents and grandchildren, between young and old. God wants young people to bring joy to the hearts of the elderly, as Mary did to Elizabeth, and gain wisdom from their [grandparents and the elderly] experiences..... The Lord trusts that young people, through their relationships with the elderly, will realize that they are called to cultivate memory and recognize the beauty of being part of a much larger history. Friendship with an older person can help the young to see life not only in terms of the present and realize that not everything depends on them and their abilities. For the elderly, the presence of a young person in their lives can give them hope that their experience will not be lost and that their dreams can find fulfilment. Mary's visit to Elizabeth and their shared awareness that the Lord's mercy is from generation to generation remind us that, alone, we cannot move forward, much less save ourselves, and that God's presence and activity are always part of something greater, the history of a people."

GOD BE WITH YOU, FR. STEVE!

Beginning this Sunday (July 23), Fr. Steve will be traveling to France for a 2 week pilgrimage by walking a portion of the Camino de Santiago (The Way of St. James). The pilgrimage concludes at the shrine of the Apostle Saint James the Great in the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in northwestern Spain, where tradition holds that the remains of the apostle are buried. May the Lord watch over Fr. Steve, and all pilgrims, grant him safe travels, and may he receive many graces during this time. We'll be praying daily for you, Fr. Steve!

PARISH DIRECTORY UPDATE

If you were not able to have your photo taken during our parish directory photography dates, we are now accepting submitted photos. The preference of the directory company is to have these submitted digitally. This means that you will need to email us the photo you want to have included in the directory. If possible,

it should be a vertical photo rather than a wide-shot horizontal picture. A few things to keep in mind:

- If the photo was professionally taken (except by a church directory company), you will need to get a copyright release.
- If you are taking a photo of a photo, set the camera resolution to the highest setting. Scanning the photo at high resolution works even better.
- Send the photo as an attachment via email to the parish address; st clement@tds.net.
- In the email, be sure to tell us the names of everyone in the photo, children oldest to youngest.
- The photo should be in either .pdf or .jpg form.
- The cost for photo submission is \$15.00. This is what the parish has to pay the company for submitted photos. You will receive a directory by doing so.
- If you do not have email, stop at the office, and we can scan the photo for you.
- Please submit your photo to the parish office by July 31! If you have any questions, contact Bill Manthe at the parish office.
