This Friday, September 1, we will again be having First Friday Adoration of our Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration is a beautiful action of love. Think of the people



in your life whom you adore. Most likely they include your spouse, children, grandchildren and long-time friends. You love them so dearly. We have, or should have, an even greater love and devotion for the One who loved us to the point of His own offering of Himself on the cross. As St. John says, "We love Him because He first loved us." Join us this Friday in Adoration of our Lord Jesus in Holy Sacrament. Whether it be for an hour, 30 minutes, 20 or 10, it will be time well spent. And it can be transformative.

Below is personal reflection on Adoration from the Archdiocese of Detroit.

There is something remarkable about being completely known and understood. Sometimes I just release a big breath and say, "Whew! I'm here." I feel like I'm just falling into the arms of love. this week! GriefShare is a faith-based




