WHERE ARE WE IN THE PROCESS OF INTO THE DEEP?

Dear Parishioners of Pastorate #1:

On the first Sunday of every month, I will publish an article in the bulletin which covers where we are in the process of the Into the Deep initiative. I will discuss what has occurred in the previous month and provide you with more information about what we have been working on as a pastorate and where we are going.

Summary of July 2023

- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar moved into their respective rectories.
- Fr. Steve and Fr. Mark are living in the St. Clement rectory. Fr. Sudhakar is living in the Bloomington rectory.
- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar moved into their respective offices.
- Fr. Steve and Fr. Mark have established offices in St. Clement, and Fr. Sudhakar has established his office in Bloomington.
- Fr. Steve visited the 7 banks of the 7 churches and transferred authorization from the outgoing priest to himself.
- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar attended a 2 day meeting for priests in Madison.
- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar gained valuable insights into each others' working habits and gained wisdom to share with the staff of the 7 churches with respect to teamwork.
- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar held their first staff meeting with staff members from the 7 churches.
- Priests and staff met for the first time to start to get to know each other and build relationships within the staff.
- Fr. Steve, Fr. Mark, and Fr. Sudhakar completed the mass schedule for August 2023.
- The mass schedule for August has been established, which takes into account Fr. Steve's 2 week pilgrimage on the Camino del Santiago. In general, Fr. Steve will be present to Cassville, Potosi, and Tennyson in August, Fr. Mark to Lancaster, and Fr. Sudhakar to Glen Haven, Patch Grove, and Bloomington. The celebrant of Sunday masses will be published in the bulletin.
