

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY 2023

Each year on the third Sunday of September, the Church in the United Sates observes Catechetical Sunday. The theme for this year is, "Come to Me, all you who are burdened." Jesus invites all of us, young people and adults alike, to come to Him to find rest from our cares. We are to learn from Him, for He is meek and humble

of heart. Jesus Himself is the Good News that we proclaim. He is the Master Catechist, as He shows us in word and deed the Kingdom of God.

Catechesis is more than sharing information about God and our Catholic faith. It necessarily includes knowing personally our Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ. Thus, evangelization is the Church's deepest identity. Catechesis nourishes, forms and deepens the faith one receives through the ministry of the Church. The Church is missionary by her very nature. For teachers, catechists and clergy, their missionary territory are the classrooms, churches and communities in which they serve.

As we commission our teachers and catechists from our school and religious education programs this weekend, we must be mindful of our own mission. Each one of us by virtue of our baptism is called to live our faith and to bear witness to the Gospel in our families, friends, parish communities and society. To share in the Church's mission of evangelization and catechesis is to grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ by coming to Him to be nourished in Word and Sacrament, in prayer and worship. All of us, ordained and laity, are commissioned to "Go Make Disciples."
