JESUS AND THE EUCHARIST

Blessed Carlo Acutis was chosen to be one of the patrons for the National Eucharistic Revival. At the recent Diocesan Eucharistic Congress in Waunakee, there was a beautiful icon of Blessed Carlo and imbedded into it was a relic, a small clipping of his hair. The Eucharist was so important to Carlo, it was his spiritual nourishment.

As one person put it, "We look to his [Carlo's] example of holiness because of his great love for the Eucharist in both the ordinary and the extraordinary moments of life, particularly during his battle with leukemia, which took his life at age 15. Carlo's words say it all: 'Jesus is Love, and He has made Himself food and drink for us in the Eucharist. The more we nourish ourselves on the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ, the more we are able to love...The Eucharist configures us in a special way to God, who is Love."

As part of the <u>National Eucharistic Revival</u>, the Diocese of Madison is building small groups in each pastorate to take part in "Jesus and the Eucharist," a 7-session reflective study. Participants will have the opportunity to grow in their knowledge and love of our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, and to grow in community with other faith-filled Catholics.
